This funding will be used to


- Increase students attaining 'C or above' in English from 68% to 90% in Year 3.
- Increase students attaining 'C or above' in English from 90% to 100% in Year 5
- Increase students attaining 'C or above' in English from 70% to 90% in Year 6.
- Maintain the percentage of Year 3 students meeting National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading at 100%
- Maintain the percentage of Year 3 students meeting (NMS) in Spelling at 100%
- Maintain the percentage of Year 5 students meeting (NMS) in Reading at 100%
- Increase the percentage of Year 5 students meeting (NMS) in spelling from 87.5% to 100%

Our initiatives include

- Improve student outcomes in reading through the implementation of professional development, focussed upon proven researched based pedagogies.
- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Improve teacher capability through Professional development around the explicit teaching of reading and data analysis.
- Improve teacher capability to improve student outcomes through the continued Implementation of a school reading intervention model focussing upon early reading development and graph phonic knowledge and awareness.
